Completed forms and payment will also be accepted at the Town Office. If you need a paper form mailed to you, please contact the Town Office at 306-322-2232. If using Canada Post for registration please keep in mind the meal ticket deadlines. Payment must be received by the deadline to order meals from the caterers, if your form gets delayed in the mail we will not be able to adjust the meal order with the caterer. Payment may be made by cash (in the Town Office), cheque or e-transfer per the instruction on the Registration Form. An admail copy of the registration form will also be sent out locally.

<u>Option 4: Walk-in Registration at the Birthday Bash</u>: Walk in registration will be accepted at the Rec Complex during the Registration times, however meals tickets for the catered Pancake Breakfast and BBQ supper will not be available. Payment at the event must be in CASH.



These communities have functioning hotels/motels. Unfortunately, the Rose Valley Hotel is no longer renting out rooms.

Rose Valley Campground

The Rose Valley Campground has only 4 sites which are rented on a first come first serve basis.
