The Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) program, previously known as the federal Gas Tax Fund program in Saskatchewan, is administered by the provincial government to help support municipalities.

From 2005 to 2024 the Town of Rose Valley has been allocated \$309,920.71 in funding from the Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) program, previously known as the federal Gas Tax Fund program. Use of \$125,000 of this funding for replacement of 14 hydrants throughout the Town has been approved by the program.
